The 2025 Budget will be adopted under the regular session meeting. The Budget was approved by the State of NJ and now must be adopted. There are multiple resolutions pertaining to the Budget.

There is not much going on with the building. Everything seems to be in good shape. Commissioner Stelling and Administrator Newberry will investigate the best investment option for the \$107,000 that the Board has allocated for the future purchase of a new fire truck. The Board will also move \$46,750 from the operating account to the payroll account at Ocean First Bank. The amount was determined by \$10,750 for Commissioner's stipends, and \$36,000 for salaries and wages. Formal action will be taken during regular sessions.

<u>Equipment</u> – Truck 1-76 went out for preventive maintenance. Truck 1-89 there was a small leak discovered and went out for repairs. Administrator Newberry met with Goldfinch Communications, who came and repaired the new Chief's car. It turned out the radio problem was with the antennas installed during the upfit of the vehicle. Goldfinch will also work up a proposal for installing a headset system in the rescue truck. Will be getting estimates for repairing the graphics on the Asst. Chief's car. Trucks that are in need of new tires will have them replaced in the engine room.
